- Must currently be a high school senior or a full time 4 year college undergraduate who is a resident of Lake Havasu City or Desert Hills.
- Must be enrolled in college preparatory classes if a high school student.
- Must have a college degree goal in a natural science preferably an earth science.
- The high school student must have minimum cumulative unweighted Grade Point Average of 3.2 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must submit at least one letter of recommendation.
- Must submit an official transcript.
- Must submit a brief essay which discusses future plans or goals related to science.
